

## **Scholarships –February 2015**

### **1. South Dakota Opportunity Scholarship**

- a. \$5000 over Four Years
- b. Applicant must attend a South Dakota college or technical school
- c. Applicant must complete the Regents Scholar Curriculum with a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or better, an ACT score of 24 or higher, and no grade below a C in the core classes. The Regents Scholar Curriculum is
  - i. 4 credits of English
  - ii. 3 credits of Social Studies
  - iii. 4 credits of algebra or higher mathematics
  - iv. 4 credits of Science
  - v. 1 credit of Fine Arts
  - vi. .5 credit of economics or personal finance
  - vii. .5 credit of physical education
  - viii. 2 credits of either of the following or a combination of the two
    - Approved CTE courses
    - Modern or classical language
- d. Beginning with the Fall 2013 term, students can also establish eligibility for the scholarship by obtaining a composite ACT score of 28 and meeting college readiness benchmarks in the areas of English (18), Reading (21), Mathematics (22), and Science (24)
- e. Deadline –September 1<sup>st</sup> of the year you will be starting college
- f. Application is available at <http://sdos.sdbor.edu/>

### **2. South Dakota iHELP Scholarship**

- a. (5) \$1000 scholarships
- b. Scholarship winners will be chosen at random. Every scholarship application will be automatically entered into a drawing for a free iPad
- c. Application is available in the guidance office
- d. Deadline – March 31, 2015

### **3. Yankton College Scholarship Program**

- a. (20) \$1,000
- b. Applicants must A) have a family relationship to Yankton College alumni, former faculty or staff; or B) a family friend, teacher, pastor or other person with a connection to Yankton College may recommend the applicant.
- c. Applicant must be seeking a four-year degree from an accredited university or college as a full-time student.

**4. South Dakota Fire Service Scholarship Program**

- a. (2) \$1,000
- b. Applicant must be the son/daughter of any member (living, deceased or retired) of a fire department in South Dakota or an active member of a junior fire department in South Dakota
- c. Applicant must be sponsored by a fire department that has 100% membership in the SD Firefighters Association of the current year
- d. Applicant must be sponsored by a member of the SD Firefighters Auxiliary, a local fire department Auxiliary or a member of the Dear Old Timers
- e. Application is available in the guidance office
- f. *Deadline – March 15, 2015*

**5. South Dakota Amateur Softball Scholarship**

- a. (17) \$500.00
- b. Applicant must be a senior who has been involved in the South Dakota ASA program, or who has a parent/guardian who has participated in this program at least 3 years as a player, coach, umpire SDASA official, or league official
- c. Application is available in the guidance office
- d. *Deadline – March 1, 2015*

**6. Curtis Marvin Hohn Scholarship**

- a. \$1,000
- b. Applicant must plan on attending a public or private college, university, or technical school in South Dakota
- c. Preference will be given to applicants pursuing studies in history, political science, or water resources (water conservation, water quality, hydraulics, water system management or operation, or environment).
- d. Application is available in the guidance office
- e. *Deadline – March 10, 2015*

**7. Home Builders Association of the Sioux Empire**

- a. Multiple \$1,000 scholarships
- b. Applicant must reside in Lincoln, McCook, Minnehaha or Turner County
- c. See scholarship application for required courses or study to apply
- d. Application is available in the guidance office
- e. *Deadline – April 1, 2015*

**8. Minnehaha Funeral Home Scholarship**

- b. Applicant must be in the top 25% of his/her class as of January 2014, be accepted in a South Dakota college or university, and be enrolled in a Tribe or a descendent of a Tribal enrollee.

**16. Build Dakota Scholarship Program**

- a. 300 scholarships in first 5 years of scholarship
- b. Scholarship will cover tuition, fees, books and other required program expenses at the eligible technical institute programs
- c. Applicant must be pursuing a course of study in a “*high demand work force-area*”: *Welding, Precision Manufacturing, Automotive, Licensed Practical Nursing, Building Trades/Construction, Energy, Engineering Technicians, Med Lab Technicians*
- d. Applicant must demonstrate financial need, and demonstrate aptitude through one or more of the following
  - 1. NCRC or other industry-recognized certifications in the career area
  - 2. Technical, dual or concurrent coursework completed in the career interest area
  - 3. Career and Technical Education coursework completed in the career interest area

- f. Following graduation, the student must work full-time in the field of study in South Dakota for a minimum of three years

**17. BBB Student of Integrity Award Scholarship**

- a. (2) \$2,000 for SD students
- b. The Student of Integrity Award scholarships are not based on ethnicity or grade point average.
- c. Award is to recognize high school students who personify the values of leadership, integrity, humility, courage, compassion and respect.
- d. Applicant must be looking to further their education after high school graduation

    - 5. *Deadline – March 15, 2015*

- iv. **Cogley-Buffington Certified Property and Casualty Underwriters Fund**

- 1. \$1,000

2. Must attend a four year college, have a 3.5+ GPA, demonstrate financial need, participate in extra-curricular and community activities
3. Must have an interest in and understanding of the role of business in American society.
4. *Deadline – March 15, 2015*

v. **Dale Lokke Law Enforcement Scholarship**

1. \$400
2. Must graduate from Minnehaha County public or private high school
3. Must attend a South Dakota college or university, have participated in extra-curricular and community activities, and demonstrate a desire and ability to succeed in his/her chosen career field.
4. *Deadline – March 15, 2015*

vi. **Davenport Evans Scholarship**

1. \$2,500
2. Must graduate from Brookings, Lake, Lincoln, McCook, Minnehaha, Moody, or Turner county high schools
3. Must have a high academic achievement based on GPA, class rank, and ACT
4. Must attend a college/university in South Dakota
5. Must demonstrate a strong desire to pursue and meet educational goals
6. *Deadline – March 15, 2015*

vii. **David Jay Schmidt Memorial Scholarship \*\***

1. \$2,500
2. Available only to Dell Rapids High School Students
3. Must plan to attend a college, university, or technical school
4. Cannot be ranked in the top 10% of graduating class
5. Must have participated in extra-curricular and community activities and demonstrate financial need
6. Preference is given to qualified students who have not received other scholarship awards
7. *Deadline – March 15, 2015*

viii. **David Profilet Scholarship**

1. \$500
2. Must plan to attend Augustana College in Sioux Falls
3. Must have GPA of 3.0 or higher GPA, demonstrate financial need, show character traits such as courage, determination, and ability to overcome adversity
4. *Deadline - April 1, 2015*

ix. **Fred and Marie Christopherson Scholarship**

1. \$2,500
2. Must attend a four year college or university in South Dakota
3. Must have minimum GPA of 3.9 after seven semesters and minimum ACT score of 28
4. *Deadline – March 15, 2015*

x. **Gloria Beck Scholarship \*\***

1. \$750
2. Available only to Dell Rapids High School Students
3. Must plan to attend Augustana College in Sioux Falls
4. Must have GPA of 3.0 or higher and be involved in community activities and community service
5. *Deadline – March 15, 2015*

xi. **Herman and LaVerne Griller Scholarship**

1. \$3,000
2. Must be a graduate of high school in Minnehaha, Lincoln, Turner or McCook county who plans to attend and accredited college/university
3. Must have GPA of 3.0 and higher and demonstrate financial need
4. *Deadline – March 15, 2015*

xii. **Jeremy Baum Hope Scholarship \*\***

1. \$1,500
2. Must be a graduate or graduating senior of Dell Rapids High School or a person who has earned a GED or equivalent and resides in Dell Rapids
3. Must demonstrate financial need and plan to attend a college, university, or technical school.

xiii. **Jerry Hoftiezer Memorial Scholarship \*\***

1. (2) \$1,250
2. Available only to Dell Rapids High School Students
3. Must attend a four year college/university and be involved in school and community activities
4. Special consideration given to students who have a 3.0+ GPA and have taken or will complete five math courses, including AP Calculus
5. Applicant not required to pursue a math-related college major
6. *Deadline – March 15, 2015*

xiv. **Joe Foss “An American Hero” Scholarship**

1. \$1000
2. Must attend a college, university, or technical school

3. Must have a GPA of 3.5+, ACT score of 21+, and demonstrate characteristics of an American patriot
4. *Deadline – March 15, 2015*

xv. **Junior League of Sioux Falls Scholarship**

1. \$500
2. Must be a female student that resides in Minnehaha or Lincoln County
3. Must attend a college, university or technical school
4. Must have minimum ACT score of 23
5. *Deadline – April 1, 2015*

xvi. **Osmann Family Native American Scholarship**

1. \$1,000
2. Must graduate from South Dakota high school and be an enrolled member of a Native American tribe
3. Must plan to attend a South Dakota college, university or a technical school in Sioux Falls, Watertown, Mitchell, or Rapids City
4. Must have GPA 2.5 or higher and have desire and ability to succeed and further academic study
5. Must have participated in extra-curricular activities and community service
6. *Deadline – March 15, 2015*

xvii. **Regina “Grandma” Evans Scholarship**

1. \$500
2. Must graduate from a public or private school in Dell Rapids
3. Must plan to attend an accredited technical school for four-year academic college or university
4. Must have a GPA of 2.0 or higher
5. *Deadline – March 15, 2015*

xviii. **Sally Bertina Meyer Scholarship**

1. \$800
2. Must attend a high school in Minnehaha County
3. Must plan to attend a four year college or university
4. Must have a GPA of 3.0+ and show an interest in the outdoors and have the desire and ability to succeed in further academic study

### Scholarship Tips:

1. Applications should be typed!!
2. If necessary, scan in the application and type it.
3. Ask for references in advance...usually one to two weeks. Provide reference person with a copy of the scholarship application along with information about yourself – could be a copy of your resume from SD MyLife.
4. Keep a copy of all scholarship applications you complete...could use parts (essays) later for another scholarship application.
5. Proofread for grammatical and spelling errors... have someone else proofread your applications and essays.
