DELL RAPIDS HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR PRIVILEGES FOR 2016-2017

The senior class is being given open-campus privileges (Senior Privileges) for the 2016-2017 school year.

Seniors who qualify will have the opportunity to leave the building during one period per term and are allowed to leave the school during their lunch period.

The privileges are granted to individual seniors for as long as they continue to uphold school policies and the regulations listed below.

Policy Regulations

- Students must either leave the building or go to the senior hallway, study hall, or library. Those desiring to
 use the study hall or library should not disturb others and are subject to all room regulations. Those students
 wishing to stay in the senior hallway may do so in a responsible and non-disruptive way.
- 2. Excessive tardies or absences will result in a loss of privileges.
- 3. Unexcused absences, in-school suspension, misconduct in school or at school-sponsored functions, or violations of school rules will lead to a loss of privileges.
- 4. Students failing a course will be denied privileges.
- 5. Students scoring lower than a C- (1.67) GPA average or those who have failed a course from the last grading period will be denied privileges until midterm of the next grading period.
- 6. A cooperative attitude in the classroom and a willingness to cooperate with school policies are required. Staff members may request removal of privileges for any student at any time.
- 7. Students who lose senior privileges will also lose open lunch privileges. Leaving school at lunch (without permission) is considered an unexcused absence and will result in additional consequences.
- 8. Duration for denial of privileges for instances not stated will be at the principal's discretion.
